## BYLAW NO. 4/2005

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE RAISING OF DOMESTIC RATS.

Pursuant to section 216(f) of the Rural Municipality Act, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Clayton No. 333, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- No person shall keep, harbour or raise any "domestic" rats or any other rats of the Genus Rattus as pets or raise rats as a commercial enterprise within the boundaries of the Rural Municipality of Clayton No. 333.
- 2. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to penalties set forth in the bylaw to provide for the enforcement of bylaws within the municipality.
