RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF CLAYTON NO. 333

BYLAW NO. 2/2013

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE TO APPLY EXEMPTIONS TO ASSESSMENTS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Clayton No. 333 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

This bylaw may be referred to as "The Assessment Procedures Bylaw".

2. In this bylaw:

a) "Act" shall mean "The Municipalities Act";

b) "Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Clayton No. 333;

c) "Administrator" shall mean the Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Clayton No. 333.

A person desiring to have an exemption applied to an improvement under Section 293 of Act shall furnish the Administrator of the Municipality with written notice, signed by the owner, on or before March 31 in the year in which the rescission or amendment is to be effective, stating the following;

a) The Legal Land descriptions of all land to be used in the exemption;

b) The Municipality in which the land is located;

c) Proof of Ownership of an improvement if different from the land owner;

For years of revaluation the deadline date may be extended by resolution of council.
