The Rural Municipality of Clayton No. 333 assumes ownership of the portion of an approach which is on the municipal road allowance. Ownership does not apply to approaches along provincial highways.

Whereas the purpose of an approach is primarily to provide access to the adjacent property owner; it shall be the responsibility of each property owner to maintain their approaches, which may include snow removal and or gravelling.

Any repairs, shall be at the discretion of council and shall receive council consent prior to work being undertaken.

Costs of replacements or alterations, including widening, if approved by Council, shall be solely the landowners responsibility. All work must meet RM standards. All requests for new approaches shall be brought to council for approval, On approval of a new approach a culvert may be supplied at the RM cost.
