A Bylaw of the R.M. of Clayton No. 333, Saskatchewan respecting the expropriation of Land. for a channel diversion.

The Council of the R.M. of Clayton No. 333, Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Council of the R.M. of Clayton No. 333, Saskatchewan deems it necessary to acquire land to be used for a channel diversion, and cannot do so by agreement with the owner, who is Cornelius Braun, Hague, Saskatchewan.
2. It shall be lawful for the Council of the said municipality to expropriate One Hundred (100) feet by Seven Hundred Twenty Five (725) feet approximate between Station 0 & 00 and Station 7 & 25 between the two curves/on the Swan River as shown on map of the Municipal Affairs Dept, Rural Affairs Division map dated May 20th, 1976. This map showing the location on the North West quarter of Section Nineteen(19), in Township Thirty Six(36), in Range One(1), West of the Second Meridian. The above land to be used as a channel diversion and the municipality is to proceed in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Expropriation Act.
