BYLAW TO DESIGNATE MUNICIPAL HERITAGE PROPERTY Section 12, The Heritage Property Act, R.S.S. 1978, c.H-2.2, as amended

> BYLAW No. 1/96

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Clayton No. 333

to designate a site as Municipal Heritage Property.

WHEREAS Sections 11 and 12 of the Heritage Property Act authorize the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has determined that the lands and premises known as:

The St. Andrew's Ukrainian Congregation of the United Church of Canada

and located at:

From Swan Plain, one (1) mile north on Number 8 Highway.

is a site of architectural, historical, cultural, environmental, archaeological, palaeontological, aesthetic and/or scientific value; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has caused, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, a Notice of Intention to Designate to be:

served on the owners of said property;

served on the Registrar of Heritage Property; registered on the Certificate of Title for said property

in the appropriate Land Titles Office; and, d. published in at least one issue of a newspaper with general circulation in the Municipality; and,

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the Council of the Munici pality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality enacts as follows:

There is designated as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as:

All that portion of the South West quarter of Section thirty-five (35) in Township Thirty-six (36)

in Range One (1)

West of the Second Meridian, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, containing Three (3) acres, more or less, bounded as follows: Commencing at the South West corner of the said quarter section; thence North along the Western boundary of the said quarter section a distance of Five hundred (500) feet; thence East and parallel with the Southern boundary of said quarter section a distance of Two Hundred and sixty-one and four tenths (261.4) feet; thence South and parallel with the said Western boundary a distance of Five Hundred (500) feet more or less, to a point in said Southern boundary; thence Westerly along said Southern boundary a distance of Two hundred and sixty-one and four tenths (261.4) feet, more or less, to the point of commencement. EXCEPTING THEREFROM:

FIRSTLY: All that portion designated as Parcel "B" containing Twenty Hundredths (0.20) of an acre, more or less, taken for a Public Roadway as shown on a Plan thereof registered in the Land Titles Office for the Yorkton Land Registration District
