DUST SUPPRESSANT ORDERS:

1. Dust suppressant is applied under municipal guidelines and only Council approved products shall be used on municipal roads.
2. The property owner is responsible to measure and mark the application area with green stakes one week prior to delivery. Stakes must be removed immediately after application and stored for future use. Stakes are available at the Municipal Office.
3. Dust suppressant order deadline is: **May 11, 2026 by 4:00pm**

COST & BILLING:

4. Billing is based on the total litres of dust suppressant applied, not by the linear distance of the site or the ordered amount. Discrepancies of +/- 3 linear metres between ordered and applied amount are not subject to dispute.
5. The 2026 dust suppressant unit rate is: \$0.45 per litre of calcium chloride dust suppressant.
6. Litres applied is calculated according to the following formula:

$$\text{Total Litres Applied} = \text{Length of Site (metres)} \times \text{Width of Application (metres)} \times \text{Application Rate (Litres/metre)}$$

7. Total invoice cost is calculated using the following formula:

$$\text{Total Invoice Cost} = (\text{Total Litres Applied} \times \text{Unit Rate}) + \text{PST}$$

8. In the event that charges for completed custom dust control remain unpaid at year end, the property owner understands that these unpaid charges will be added to and form part of the property taxes (Section 405 of *The Municipalities Act*). Please note that the Municipality may refuse services for delinquent accounts.

MAINTENANCE OF APPLICATION SITES:

9. Dust control sites shall be graded and cared for as the road is a municipal asset. The staff will try their best to only grade the site when it is wet with heavy dew or rain, but this is not always an option and occasional dry grading is required for public safety.
