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2024-00073	Letter from Kreklewich & Chambers Moved by: Councillor Ron Perepeluk THAT the Rural Municipality of Clayton No. 333 deny the refund request of \$1,200.00 by Owner No. 1035 pursuant to Section 278 of <i>The Municipalities Act</i>: <i>"278(1) Notwithstanding The Limitations Act, an action or other proceeding for the return by a municipality of any money paid to the municipality, whether under protest or otherwise, as a result of a claim by the municipality, whether valid or invalid, for payment of taxes or tax arrears must be commenced within six months after the payment of the money to the municipality.</i> <i>(2) If no action or other proceeding is commenced within the period mentioned in subsection (1), the payment made to the municipality is deemed to have been a voluntary payment."</i> In addition to this, Owner No. 1035 has never had a water and sewer account in Swan Plain therefore was not charged for water and sewer services. Council would like to note that when the initial request of a \$1,800.00 refund was received, Owner No. 1035 was advised to contact the Organized Hamlet Board directly as the refund would be paid from the Organized Hamlet reserve account which requires an Organized Hamlet Board resolution. In regards to the claim of the safety concerns resulting from the neighbor's crumbling foundation and eligibility to be on the Organized Hamlet Board, these claims have been put forth by Owner No. 1035 due to a personal vendetta against his neighbor.  - Administration will send out letters and forms via email or mail to previous customers of the Dust Control Program as well as to new applicants;
 - The Property Owner shall be responsible to sign the Dust Control Contract of Understanding and to order the suppressant prior to the Dust Control Program deadline;
 - Applicants/Property Owners will be invoiced for the dust control suppressant amounts applied, not ordered, as per the supplier's field sheets. Differences of plus or minus 10 feet between the ordered and applied amount will not be disputed and/or investigated;

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- The Municipality shall pay for 50% of the dust control suppressant for residents located along:
 - The Dyck Memorial Road Alternate Truck Route; and
 - Gravel pit roads used for municipal purposes (Melvina Babiuk, Danny Turta, Wesley Matiece, Shawn Foster and Duane Hicks);
- The 2023 Dust Control arrears must be paid in full prior to the Dust Control Program application deadline or the applicant will not be eligible for Dust Control in 2024. All Dust Control Arrears shall be transferred to taxes prior to June 2024 as per Section 405 of *The Municipalities Act*; and
- The 2024 Dust Control Program application deadline date shall be set by the Administrator.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Clayton No. 333 recognizes the central role trees play in wind and snow protection, carbon sequestration, oxygen production, and habitat development and is interested in our rural residents' participation in HELP International's proposed Free Tree/Tree Mulch/Drip Irrigation materials program under the federal government's Two Billion Tree Initiative.

Our region is considered semi-arid to arid by international rainfall standards. The addition of plastic mulch and drip irrigation would greatly heighten the success in establishing trees and lessen the maintenance burden on landowners. The use of plastic mulch film also eliminates the need for recurrent cultivation and eliminates the need for chemical weed control. Drip Irrigation for tree installations is as an important water conservation technology that helps preserve limited dugout and well water supplies for humans and livestock.
